Description of Gymnastics Party:

The party will begin with one hour of instruction/open play time in the gymnastics arena, followed by 30 minutes off the floor for treats/gifts. Our entire facility will be available for you! The staff will help set up all party decorations, lead games and supervise play on the floor, serve food, and clean up. Please be aware that parents are not allowed on the floor unless their child is under 3, and parents are not able to use the equipment while they're supervising.

Total time of gymnastics birthday party: 1 ½ Hour

Cost: \$325 Members \$350 Nonmembers \$75 add on ½ hr.

Includes 20 children (Additional children are \$15.00 each)

Rules/Regulations: (Please initial after each item.)

1. Party Cost is \$325/\$350 which includes 20 children and \$15/child after that. A confirmed headcount will be required the week prior to the party for appropriate staffing. [REDACTED]
2. A deposit of \$100.00 to secure the date/time of the party is non-refundable. [REDACTED]
3. Each guest's parent/guardian MUST sign a waiver for participation prior to activity in the gymnastics arena. Waivers will be available at the front desk the day of the event and can also be provided to you prior to the event to distribute with invitations. [REDACTED]
4. The Party Area will be available to you 15 minutes prior to your scheduled party time. [REDACTED]
5. Alcoholic Beverages are not allowed in the gym. [REDACTED]
6. Birthday parent(s) must remain in the building until all guests have been picked up. [REDACTED]
7. You can bring in your own themed paper products and food items. (No peanut products allowed) [REDACTED]
8. This is a supervised party. Your party coach will RUN the party for you! They will lead and supervise activities on the gym floor and assist with food, gifts, and clean-up. [REDACTED]
9. No food or drinks of any kind will be allowed on the gymnastics floor. Once a student has eaten they are not permitted back onto the floor. [REDACTED]
10. Only children in appropriate attire will be allowed on the gymnastics floor. No jeans, buttons, zippers, or street shoes. Clothing should be flexible and easy to move in. [REDACTED]
11. Cubbies will be provided for shoes and similar items. [REDACTED]
12. Participating children must be able to attend the party in the gymnastics arena without parental supervision and be able to follow the party coach. Guests under 3 years old require a parent to accompany them. [REDACTED]
13. Parents WILL NOT be allowed on the equipment. [REDACTED]
14. . Flash photography is not permitted while the guests are doing playtime. [REDACTED]
15. All children and adults must abide by our safety rules. If rules are disrespected, we may end the party early and no refund will be provided. [REDACTED]

Covid Policy regarding birthday guests'

Illness

We will have zero tolerance for any illness. Gymnasts and their families must be symptom-free. Your gymnast must not have a runny nose, sore throat, cough, fever, nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea to attend the party.

Contact your doctor concerning flu-like symptoms to determine if your child should test for COVID-19. Symptoms of coronavirus are vast from “flu-like” to “gastrointestinal issues.” **DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO THE PARTY IF SHE/HE OR ANYONE IN YOUR FAMILY HAS FLU OR COVID-19 SYMPTOMS.**

If your child has any illness (confirmed by her doctor) other than COVID-19, she/he must be symptom-free and fever-free for 24 hours. Fever-free means no fever for 24 hours while not using a fever reducer such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen.

If your gymnast has allergies or asthma, you need to inform us on an event-by-event basis. If you have not informed us, we will assume she/he is ill and seclude her/him until we can contact you.

If anyone in your family living in your house tests positive for COVID-19, your gymnast must wait at least 10 days and conform to the latest health department guidelines to start or resume class. If your gymnast or any of your family has exposure to COVID-19, your gymnast must wait 10 days to return to class, or show proof of a negative test result, 3-5 days after exposure, then they can return without waiting the 10 days. The same rules apply to coaches and staff.

Personal Hygiene

Participants will have his/her hands sanitized upon entering the gym floor.
